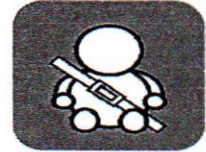

"Click!" That's the sound of safety. That's the sound of survival. That's the sound of a seatbelt locking in place. Seatbelts save lives and that's a fact.



A lot of people do not use seatbelts for several reasons; some drivers are afraid of getting stuck in a crashed car. They feel that they are likely to be killed or knocked unconscious and unable to get out of the car at all. If you are buckled up, you're more likely to stay in place and remain conscious, in control of the vehicle, and able to make smart decisions.

Some say that seatbelts irritate the skin on the neck or chest. But, most new vehicles have adjustable shoulder height positions that let you move the shoulder belt up or down for a more comfortable fit. Others claim that the car airbag can do the job of the seatbelt. However, If you're not buckled up, you will land in the airbag. Since it starts to deflate immediately, you will still be at risk for crashing into the steering wheel or through the windshield.

A lot of drivers feel it is unnecessary to buckle up when driving at low speeds through short trips .They claim they are **skillful** drivers and are able to avoid crashes. But, choosing to wear your seatbelt is as simple as choosing between life and death. Which one do you choose?

Think about it. When a car is going at high speed, then somebody ahead may stop suddenly, then there is no time for you to stop and the car crashes. Your body, however, is still going at the same high speed. What's going to stop your body? Will it be the windshield or your seatbelt?

Seatbelts remain the number one vehicle safety device; despite new technologies and protection measures taken. Wearing seatbelts is a necessity because it simply reduces the chances of injury by 50%, in case one meets with an accident. Airbags are also effective but they may be useless if you're not wearing a seatbelt. **It** helps keep pregnant women alive, which is the number one thing a woman can do to protect her unborn child in a car. Finally, wearing a seatbelt is a civilized action that shows your respect to rules and regulations.
