

Today, paper is used for hundreds of everyday things- books and newspapers, of course, but also money, stamps, cups, bags, and even some clothes. Thanks to the wonderful creation of paper. Paper is **vital** to the organization of modern business and economy and for entertainment purposes. Many descriptions of our world have been stored, so that we may share and learn from them.

Long ago, before paper, people wrote on animal skins, bones and stones. Then in 2700 BC, the Egyptians started to make Papyrus, which was similar to paper. But the first real paper was invented in AD 105 by a Chinese government official, Ts'ai Lun. It was made from a mixture of plants and cloth. The Chinese kept their invention secret for centuries.

Finally, in the 10th century, paper was brought to Europe by the Arabs. The first European paper mill was built in Spain in 1150. Since the 18th century, most paper has been made out of wood, because **it** was much stronger than cloth.

Nowadays, each person uses about 300 kg of paper every year. That's a lot of paper.
